#### HIGHLIGHTS

 BEA organized a daylong Webinar - Food for Soul in August. Four eminent speakers shared their insights & perspectives about food. Dr. Padayal Siva , Nidhi Tayal, Atul Shah and Anumeha delivered secrets to healthier lifestyle through balanced food habits





- A National Business Chamber for Women, Women's Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry (WICCI) aims to encourage women entrepreneurship through engagements with government, institutions, global trade and networks. BEA helped setup the National Bioenzyme Council to promote the concept and encourage micro entrepreneurs. At the moment, we have built a network of 36 members across 10 states covering 11 cities in India. The grandeur idea is to expand the network to all the 766 districts across 28 states and 8 union territories across India. Long way to go!
- BEA teamed up with Smile Foundation to assist in **Flood Relief operations at Bangalore.** You may recall some parts of Bangalore were affected due to incessant rains in September. BEA mobilized Bioenzymes from its members and guided the sanitization operation. Bioenzyme are an effective agents to unclog sewers and disinfect the areas. The initiative was applauded by local communities and administration.

 Participated in the longest coastal cleanup campaign - Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar on 17<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022, #World Coastal Cleanup Day. This nationwide drive is a 75-day citizen-led campaign for improving ocean health through collective action. This event also coincides with the celebrations of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav in 75<sup>th</sup> year of the country's independence. The coastal cleanup drive will be carried out at 75 beaches across the country with 75 volunteers for every kilometer of the coastline. BEA Members distributed Bioenzymes and helped clean the coastal areas. Our friends Eco enzyme Nusantara from Indonesia also joined us in cleaning up the coastal area in Bali





 Successfully carried out trials using Bioenzyme to control the spread of Lumpy disease. Lumpy is a viral disease that affects cows. The disease has already claimed lives of an estimated 67,000 cattle across 10 different states in India. Initial results have been encouraging. BEA is actively monitoring situation and documenting the process

### 1. Study tour to Rayong, Thailand

In July, BEA delegation travelled to Thailand to learn more about Bioenzymes and its role in controlling Global Climate Change.
